





Instrument Selection Process

- Students select 3 instrument choices to try
- Final instrument selection will be made based on student's preference and data collected during trial process
- Letter with final selection will be sent home with students at the end of September

(it can take a while for a store to get instruments in...so order ASAP!)


- 30 minute lesson during school day in every 6 day cycle

- Time of lesson rotates
- Lesson will always be on a set day of the cycle (ex: A days)

Practice Tips, Concert Dates, etc.

- Consistent practice is the key to success!
- Set a designated practice time every day, this way practicing becomes routine.
- Set up a designated practice area in your home with a music stand and chair that allows for good sitting posture. Keeping an organized and ready-to-go music area can encourage daily practicing!
- At first, beginners can become frustrated that they cannot play "songs" or "recognizable tunes" right off the bat. Ensure them that if they continue to practice, they will be playing recognizable songs soon!

Commonly Asked Questions...

Is drum set an option?

No. Percussion includes concert percussion instruments (mallet instruments, snare drum, bass drum, triangle, tambourine, etc. Students selected for percussion are expected to learn and play all percussion instruments, not just drums

Is there a maximum number of students that can be play each instrument?

Sometimes. It depends on the instrument. Percussion has a maximum of 5 students per grade. Larger band and orchestra instruments are limited to the available school instruments.

What if my family cannot afford an instrument rental price?

We believe everyone should have the opportunity to play a musical instrument in our program, and we will work with you to help make this happen for your child! There are a limited number of school instruments available for families in need, this is determined on a case-by-case basis. Please reach out to your band/orchestra teacher about this if needed.

How/When do I get the instrument!?

We will mail home paperwork once every student has had the chance to try their 3 top instrument choices. This paperwork will include suggestions for where to get an instrument and what supplies are needed. (we don't recommend buying online...⊕)
